The bid documents for this Bid shall be amended, revised and changed in the following particulars:

In response to questions from potential participants in the ITB:

Question 1: “1.C. Housing, Door, and Visor, II Door 3. States, "Neoprene gaskets >shall be provided between... and between the lenses and reflectors to >exclude dust and moisture". Since the signals you are requesting on the >bid are LED and the reflectors are sealed in the LED itself, does this >apply?”

Answer 1: C. - No, this does not apply

Question 2: “2. F. Optical Units For Light Emitting Diodes (LEDs), VII. Warranty >Requirements, states, "The warranty shall include a commitment by the >manufacturer to replace all failed LEDs at no cost the Purchaser". Our >supplier will repair or replace the defective unit.>Is this acceptable?”

Answer 2: F. - Yes, this is acceptable

Question 3: “3. H. Submittal Data Required For LEDs . 1 states, "Each LED traffic >signal lamp unit shall be provided with the following data: >Schematics for all electronics". Is this schematics for wiring the LED >into the signal or schematics for the LED itself? Also, 2. >states, "The contractor shall submit a copy of a test report certified >by an independent laboratory (i.e. Intertek Testing Services ETL Semko)>that the LED traffic signal lamp.....". The signal part numbers that >you list for reference do not include LEDs that are not on the Intertek >LED Traffic Signal Modules Certification Directory and have currently >not been tested. Should we bid the TP part number that includes LEDs in >Intertek's LED Traffic Signal Modules Certification Program or would >the city accept LEDs that are not currently in the Intertek >Certification Program?”

Answer 3: H. - We would like to strike this entirely from the specifications. (The specs we used were taken from the ALDOT specifications for traffic lights. Recent research revealed that the 9th Division of ALDOT uses different LED specifications for testing than the other divisions, due to regional variations. Our intent is to match 9th Division parts and equipment as some of the fixtures will be

on State Highways and may be subject to having the 9th Division work on them.)

Responders are to sign and include signed Addendum No.1 with submitted quotation documents.
